

COVID-19 Health Screening Survey

Per the recommendations of the Alameda County Public Health Department, Green Forest Art Studio is performing health screenings on students to check for possible symptoms of COVID-19.

| HEALTH SCREENING QUESTIONS | YES | NO |
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| (1) In the past 10 days, was the child sent home sick or absent due to illness? | | |
| (2) In the past 10 days, was the child diagnosed with COVID-19 or did the child have a test confirming that they had the virus? | | |
| <p>(3) Within the past 14 days, has the child had close contact* with anyone in the household who was diagnosed with COVID-19 or who had a test confirming they have the virus?</p> <p><i>* "Close contact" means that the child was within 6 feet of a COVID positive person for 15 minutes or longer (this includes multiple shorter periods in the same day that add up to 15 minutes) EVEN IF both the child and the other person were wearing masks.</i></p> <p><i>"Close contact" can also mean that the child had a briefer but major exposure to the COVID positive person's respiratory droplets. For example, the sick person coughed directly on the child.</i></p> | | |
| (4) Within the last 14 days, has the child had close contact* with someone outside the household who was diagnosed with COVID-19 or who had a test confirming they have the virus? | | |
| <p>Does the Child have any of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Fever (100°F/37.8°C or higher) - Cough - Severe headache - Sore throat - Loss of taste or smell. Children may say food "tastes bad" or "smells funny" - Difficulty breathing - Vomiting or diarrhea | | |
| <p>Is the Child's Temperature 100.0°F (37.8°C) or higher?</p> <p>(When checking for fever with a "non-touch" thermometer, Alameda County defines a fever as a temperature of 100°F (37.8°C) or higher.)</p> | | |
